## **Personal Coat of Arms**



In the Middle Ages, each family had their own coat of arms with symbols that held importance. Why not make your own individual (or family) coat of arms?

## Supplies:

A piece of cardboard (9" x 12")
Construction paper in various colors
Scissors
Glue stick
Photos or clip art that represent important things to your student \*

## **Directions:**

- 1. Cut a shield out of the cardboard to look like the one above.
- 2. Cover the shield with one sheet of construction paper and trim it to fit. Glue it on with a glue stick.
- 3. Using a second color, cut out a square and a triangle (see blue parts on the above shield) to fit and glue down.
- 4. Glue four different symbols of importance into the four sections of the shield.
- \* If you don't have photos or clip art, each student can draw their symbols with markers or crayons.
