Pastel Fall Leaves



This project is a nice way to record the beautiful colors of Autumn and see how powerfully the complementary colors of blue and orange work together!

Supplies:

A brightly colored fall leaf Soft Pastels Blue pastel or construction paper Kneaded eraser Blending stump or cotton swab

Directions:

- 1. Lay one or more colorful fall leaves out on the table in front of you.
- 2. Sketch each leaf: Using a yellow pastel, sketch the leaf onto the pastel paper.
- a. First, draw a line that goes from the bottom of the stem to the top of center of the leaf.
- b. Second, draw the veins that branch off the stem.
- c. Third, draw the shape of the leaf around these lines.
- 3. Render the leaf:
- a. First, carefully color in the whole leaf with a yellow pastel. Smudge this neatly with the blending stump or cotton swab.
- b. Second, add red, orange, brown or green (depending on your leaf) to areas where these colors are and neatly smudge.
- c. Third, add bold strokes of the above colors to the most striking parts of the leaf and DO NOT SMUDGE.
- d. Fourth, draw a THIN outline of dark brown around the leaf.
- 4. Clean up any extra smudges around the leaf with the kneaded eraser.
