
Foggy Boat in Charcoal



The beautiful Victory Chimes makes an intriguing subject for this easy charcoal drawing.




Supplies:

Tinted Charcoal Paper
Willow or vine charcoal
Charcoal pencil
Kneaded eraser
White pastel
Cotton ball or tissue
Blending Stump
Ruler
Victory Chimes Photo Reference (see below)
Black construction paper for mounting (optional)

Note: ALWAYS refer to the photo reference below at EVERY step!







11. Using the charcoalcovered tortillion, add the dark waves in the water. Gently smudge in the horizon area behind the ship.

12. This drawing would look best mounted on black paper, or matted with black mat board.
